

Prepare Your RV For Winter

Clean & Empty

- Deep clean interior of dirt, grime, & crumbs
- Clean the refrigerator, freezer, & defrost
- Remove foods & liquids
- Store bedding & other items in latching bins
- Clean exterior & awning
- Remove all valuables from interior & cargo

Inspect & Fix

- Inspect interior plumbing & seals
- Inspect the seals around the interior windows, doors, ceiling vents, & around slides
- Inspect exterior for bad seals, cracks, leaks (roof, windows, doors, slides, underbelly, & cargo)
- Inspect & seal for rodent intrusion

Winterize

- RV plumbing system
- Engine, generator & batteries
- RV refrigerator & ice maker
- RV washer & dryer

Park & Secure for Storage

- Park on a dry & level surface (covered areas are best)
- Avoid parking under tree limbs or in tall grassy areas
- Chock the wheels & use leveling blocks if needed
- Inflate tires to manufacturer max cold pressure
- Cover the tires
- Shut off electrical switches, appliances, and LP supply
- Remove battery & store in warm place with maintainer
- Close & lock windows, ceiling vents, cargo doors
- Close shades & curtains
- Place moisture absorbers
- Place mouse traps or repellent
- Cover external outlets & openings
- Top off gasoline or diesel & add fuel stabilizer

Routine Check

- Check for leaks, rodents, & theft
- Check for condensation, mold, or mildew
- Inspect the battery charge
- Check the tire pressure & flat spots
- Use a dehumidifier if needed
- Check the roof for branches, snow & ice
